

REMEMBRANCE DAY

- Notices-** Out by mid September at the latest
- Programmes-** Produced as soon as possible- sent to Churches/ Parade Marshall & RBL Standard Bearer before the day.
- Schools-** Reminded that individual crosses can be placed in the grass area at the rear. {if enough wish to do so, then they could come up in a continuous line after all the floral tributes are laid. Members of the public could be included in this to make it a truly community event. Would also remember those lost in more recent conflicts.}
- Rain Covers** for Speakers- adequate for sound to travel to back of crowd.
- Parade Marshall-** Top of Steps at front using Microphone.
Explain procedure for those without a programme.
Wreath Layers after Civic Dignitaries, to come up in groups of 3/4
Approx. list prepared beforehand.
As those laying **begin** to return- next group called forward.
- Standard Bearers-** Corner of Memorial Steps
Led by Royal British Legion- informed of programme beforehand.
- Wreath Layers-** Attend by 10.40; names to Marshall.
Infirm to be at top of steps.
Stand in 2 rows- first forward, rear moves forward, return behind.
If one is infirm, join at top and move forward together.
- Sodexo-** To be asked if they can fashion a 'stand' to place at the front down the steps, so wreaths can be placed upright here during the ceremony instead of lain down on the steps.
- Timing-** Maroons/Rockets timed with clock.
- Procedure-** They shall not grow old...
11am rocket- Standards dipped.
2 minute silence.
11.02am rocket- Bugle.
When you go home....
Wreath laying with Lament.
Reveille- Standards raised.
Short Service. National Anthem.
Parade to Church.
