What are you doing?

We will be carrying out carriageway resurfacing on the **C99 CHURCH STREET, AMBLE**

Who will be doing the works?

The Main Contractors for the works will be Northumberland County Council

How long will the work take?

The works are estimated to take up to 5 days (09.00 – 15.30) **Weather Permitting.**

Will the works be disruptive?

The surfacing works will need to be carried out under **Road Closure** and a diversion will be in place. Access for residents/businesses will be maintained where possible, however long delays should be expected.

Please liaise with site staff if access is required (and also if any planned deliveries are expected during the works) and they will assist.

Emergency access will be maintained at all times

Pedestrians will be guided through the site by works personnel. Members of the public **must not** attempt to cross the site when surfacing operations are being carried out as the surfacing material is very hot. Please keep within the designated walkways.

Please liaise with site staff on a day to day basis to ascertain progress and to confirm working areas

Every effort will be made to minimise the effects of noise, and the duration of the works, however some disruption and noise will be inevitable.
