# 8 – Amble Youth Project

An update was given by Matthew Mahoney.

Amble Youth Project was heavily hit in 2020 and 5 groups were shut down.

In the period July 2020 – Dec 2020 they operated a delivery parcel system.

In the summer they recommenced face to face work and in September carried out detached face to face and the parcel delivery scheme.

From January 2021, they have been able to host an outdoor youth facility, targeting vulnerable young people. Since that time as regulations have lifted, they are now able to expand their reach. They have a sheltered, covid compliant outdoor space and have taken on 3 new members of staff, they are also continuing to work in local schools.

# 9 – Any Other Business

A query was raised regarding any information on any future events that the Youth Project could get involved with. Unfortunately there is nothing set in stone and everything can change depending on government advice.

The Events Committee are not planning anything in the town until the Xmas Parade. The Colony Music Festival is billed for July subject to government restrictions being lifted.

Warkfest at Warkworth will also be going ahead but it in not clear when this will be.
