Cllr Hume was contacted by various residents regarding a community hub in Amble. It was confirmed that the former Amble First School site had been sold however no other information was available due to commercial sensitivity.

Cllr Hume reported that the Amble specification has been updated in light of his comments.

Cllr Hume is working with Advance Northumberland with regard to retail investment and is to be invited to future meeting with regeneration colleagues.

Additional buses are being provided with x3 additional x18 buses per day and will continue on to Berwick.

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Some work on the new King Edwin Primary School site has taken place. Some of the area has been fenced off while the grass grows. Cllr Davidson to liaise further with headteacher. The HUSK developments are complete and NCC are currently shortlisting applications.

The Town Council supported this application and referenced the emerging Neighborhood Plan which supports more flexible use of employment land.

**Amendment:** Cllr Rackham proposed an additional amendment to include the provision of an independent Town Council Community Impact Assessment as best practise before making a final decision, to determine what impact this will have on other providers currently working in the town.

**Second:** Cllr Joyce

Cllr McTaggart spoke against the amendment as the offer to be provided by Amble Development Trust was not yet known and the development trust have demonstrated a willingness to work alongside existing provision rather than compete against what is existing. Cllr McTaggart felt the wording in his proposal was adequate to include further scrutiny of data provided by Amble Development Trust, including impact data.

Vote for amendment: In favour – Cllrs Rackham, Joyce. Vote against - Cllrs Osborne, McTaggart, Richards, MacColl, Connolly. Abstention Cllrs Dawson, Regan.

Amendment not carried.

**Proposal:** Cllr McTaggart proposed that, pursuant to Chapter 57 of the 1976 Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, section 19, sub section 3a and chapter 70 of the 1972 Local Government Act, Section 133, subject to the outcome of a successful Community Asset Transfer decision by Northumberland County Council, and pending the receipt of the full Business Case and related data for scrutiny by Councillors, Amble Town Council resolves to grant Amble Development Trust up to £40,000 over 3 years, £15,000 in years 1 and 2 and £10,000 in year 3. To contribute to wards, but not limited to, the development and running costs of the current JCSC Sports Hall building as a Community Sports and Leisure Hub.

**Second:** Cllr Richards

Cllr Regan suggested conditions in the funding agreement should be disclosed to the Amble Development Trust in the first instance and should be agreed now.

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Standing Order 2a was invoked regarding disruptive behaviour from the public gallery. The member of the public was asked to moderate their behaviour. Discussion continued.

**Resolution:** In favour Cllrs Osborne, Dawson, Connolly, Regan, MacColl, Richards, McTaggart. Against – Cllr Joyce, Abstention – Cllr Rackham.

Cllr Richards invoked standing order 2b regarding disruptive behaviour from the public gallery. A vote of 8-1 in favour of standing order 2b, in being that the person be excluded from the meeting.

### **146.2 To note suggestions for Active Travel Corridors ahead of meeting with Northumberland County Council**

Early engagement work to take place with NCC officers regarding developing LCWIPS. Existing data for Amble is 5 years old. The Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group has been looking at 4 main corridors across the town with one of the main routes to focus on being to the proposed Tantallon new build. This would enable greater connectivity throughout the town.

### **146.3 To agree retrospective approval for contribution to Warkworth Harbour Commissioners Defibrillator Cabinet replacement of £250.**

Cllr MacColl declared an interest and left the room.

Resolved: To support Warkworth Harbour Commissioners with £250 for contribution to repair of defibrillator cabinet.

Cllr MacColl returned.
